The mission of the treatment is to prevent penetration of a liquid on the worksheet. This is possible because the surface is waterproof. This means that properties such as color, quality and workmanship for a long period unchanged with the best results.

SENSA granite resists the use of chemical cleaners such as ammonia.

The treatment is resistant to high temperatures (300 ° C) giving it a high resistance to temperature changes it.

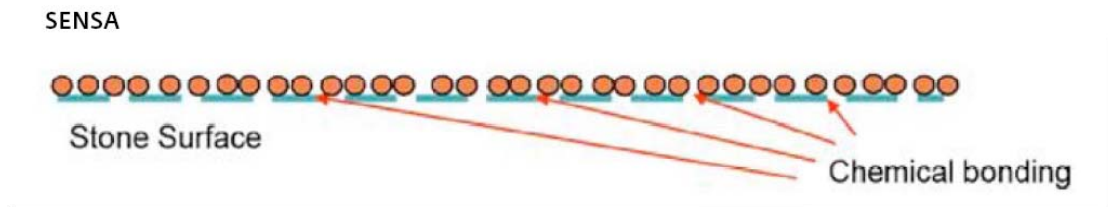

What is a SENSAs treatment?

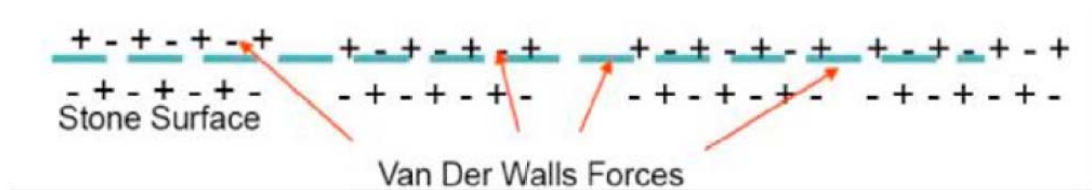
Sensa is a protective treatment that reduces the absorption of granite and therefore stains in the material occurs. Sensa is not a seal. It binds to the surface of the granite, but not in the same way as conventional seals.

Sensa granite breathe. They penetrate the structure of the stone and dedicated it fixed, while the color and the natural beauty of the stone preserved.

Thanks to its low molecular weight reacts with Sensa Granite and integrates it into its molecular structure by a chemical compound.



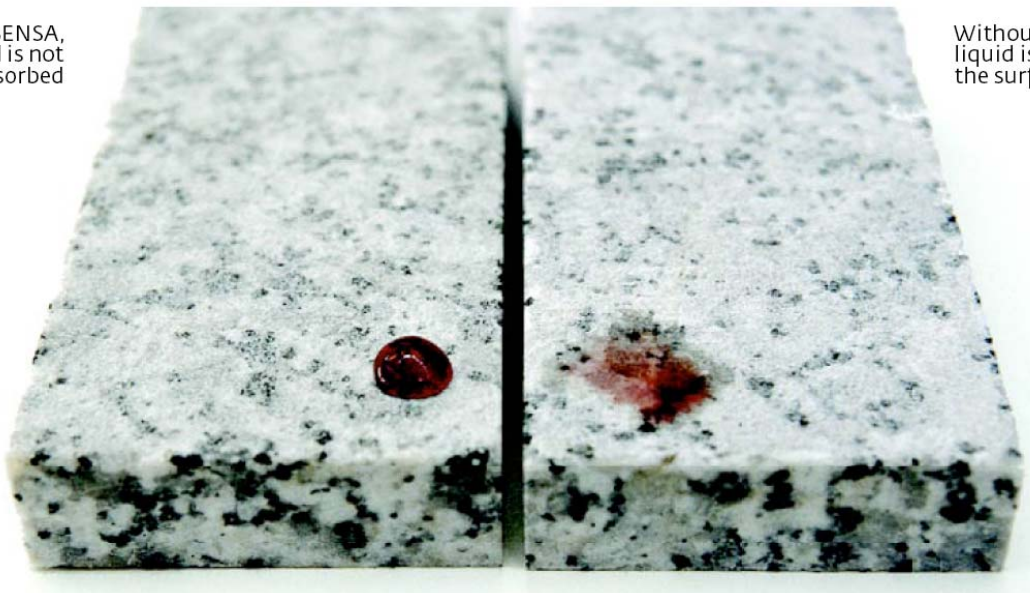

Frequently asked questions

Why should granite be sealed?

Granite is a porous stone that has the microporosity in its surface structure. Together with the surface microporosity that makes sure that liquids are absorbed. This phenomenon, called capillary absorption, leads to spots in the stone.

To what extent is the material resistant to scratches?

As previously explained, there is no surface layer on the material submitted. The scratch resistance is the resistance of the stone underneath. For treated stones it may be 7 on the Mohs scale (depending on the granite).

How is the surface maintained?

The surface is maintenance free. It is enough to clean it regularly with the methods described in the "Preventive Maintenance" to keep it as new.

Can stains be treated on a surface?

Treatment is not a panacea. Treatment only guarantees that the stone is not affected if not too long exposed to the products that cause staining (see table of resistance to stains in Section 4.4). If the times therein mentioned are exceeded, or if the stain is caused by other products like the one against which the treatment is effective, it is possible to create a stain that cannot be removed.

SENSA treatment may be used for outdoor applications?

Yes. The product used is resistant to sunlight and exposure to UV rays.

SENSA treatment may be used for floor and wall tiles?

The product can be used for wall tiles as well. But beware, if the wear caused by walking on the stone is very large, then the stone over time is so degraded, that an area will arise where the product is no longer effective (greater wear with penetration).

Materials and dimensions

The Sensa range is available in the following colors and textures:

- Abyss (Polished Leather).
- Smoke (Polished Leather).
- Tea (Polished).
- Crisol (Polished Leather).
- Tanami (Polished)
- Blat (Polished Leather)
- Boira (Polished Leather)
- Savannah (Polished Leather)

The material will be supplied in sheets of at least 2.5 x 1.5 m, unless otherwise stated, and a thickness of 2 and 3 cm.

Care and maintenance

PREVENTIVE MAINTENANCE

Thanks to the Sensa-treatment there is almost no maintenance required and the stone is highly resistant to stain the stone. To the surface as good as new, it must be cleaned regularly with a few drops of a neutral cleaning product or a mild dishwashing product.

The best results are obtained using a damp cloth with warm water and gently rubbing, to prevent the outer layer wears out. After cleaning the surface should be rinsed with water and dried.

Recommendation:

- Do not place hot objects directly on the worksheet. It is recommended to use coasters, to prevent the stone being affected.
- If the worksheet, dry it as soon as possible.
- Do not cut directly on the worksheet, or could scratch.
- Do not use abrasive materials such as metal scouring pads, maintenance and rub gently over the surface to avoid scratches.
- Do not use cleaning products that are much much acids or bases, because it can damage the outer layer.
